Event Schedule: **5/29, Saturday:** **Men SL/SL / Ladies GS** **Palmer Snowfield**
5/30, Sunday: **Men GS / Ladies SL/SL** **Palmer Snowfield**
(If weather and/or snow conditions are not suitable for racing on Palmer, the event will be moved to the lower mountain and the schedule changed to SL for all events.)

Event Registration: **Entry fees are \$40.00/race - \$120.00 for all three races.**
Entry includes a Golden Rose 75th Annual event t-shirt. Be sure to indicate your size when registering – Adult S, M, L, XL.

Note: The top 5 USSA point holders in the events contested, and who qualify under PNSA policy, will have their entry fees returned. These athletes will also be eligible for comped lift tickets.

PNSA Entry Deadline: All PNSA entries must be received by 12 noon on Tuesday, May 25th.

Out-of-division Entries: All entries from outside PNSA must be received by Thursday, 5/20/10. The total quota for out-of-division entries is 10 men and 10 women. The quota will be filled by considering all racers who have submitted a complete entry by May 20th. Competitors will be ranked by USSA SL points from the 12th list. Check the MHA web site - www.mthoodacademy.com on May 21st for a list of eligible competitors. PLEASE - no entry from out-of-division Masters racers.

Cutting the Field: Because of weather and snow conditions surrounding a race in late May, the Golden Rose will be limited to approximately 90 women and 90 men. If necessary the field will be cut by SL point ranking using the 12th USSA points list. Check the MHA web site - www.mthoodacademy.com - after 5:00pm on the 26th for a final list of entered competitors.

Lift Tickets: \$42.00 daily lift tickets for racers may be purchased each morning. The PNSA Elite Pass will be honored. Coaches' tickets may be picked up at Friday's TC meeting or at Race Headquarters each morning. Fusion Pass and Timberline Winter Pass are valid for the Golden Rose.

Race Headquarters: Race HQ will be open each morning from 6:30 to 7:30am in the Timberline Day Lodge.

Team Captains Meeting: The first team captains meeting will be 7:00pm Friday the 28th at the Mt. Hood Academy House in Government Camp. Racers must be represented to be placed on the start list for Saturday's race. The second team captains meeting will be held Saturday immediately following awards in the WyEast Day Lodge.

Racer Bibs: Bibs will be issued at Friday night's TC meeting for all competitors who have completed a Timberline Liability Release; **No Release - No Bib.** Bibs not distributed Friday night can be picked up at Race Headquarters in the morning once a release is signed. Racers will use the same bib for all races. Turn in bibs at the scoreboard after your final race. No bib deposit is required, however \$50.00 will be charged for lost or damaged bibs.

Awards: Awards will be presented each day one hour following the last run. Awards will be presented to the top 3 finishers of each race in the following age groups: J3, J2, and J1-A. The Golden Rose perpetual trophies will be presented to the overall male and female with the lowest combined Race Points from all races.

Weather: It is important to be prepared for any kind of weather on Palmer. Sunscreen and dark lens goggles are recommended, as well as winter clothing.
